GRADE 1 MUSCLE MANIA – TIP OF THE WEEK

We are delighted with how well the Grade 1's writing skills are progressing! The Grade 1's have completed their number formations (0 to 9) and accurate placement within the lines in their Happy Handwriter Number books. Please continue to encourage your children to make use of the correct formations to enable them to establish the correct motor maps. A motor map is a set of instructions stored in the brain that travels along a neural pathway to tell a group of muscles how to perform a motor action, such as forming a number. The motor map is then established through constant repetition. It is therefore very important that you encourage your children to consistently make use of the correct number and letter formations, even during incidental and informal writing opportunities. Keep practising!
