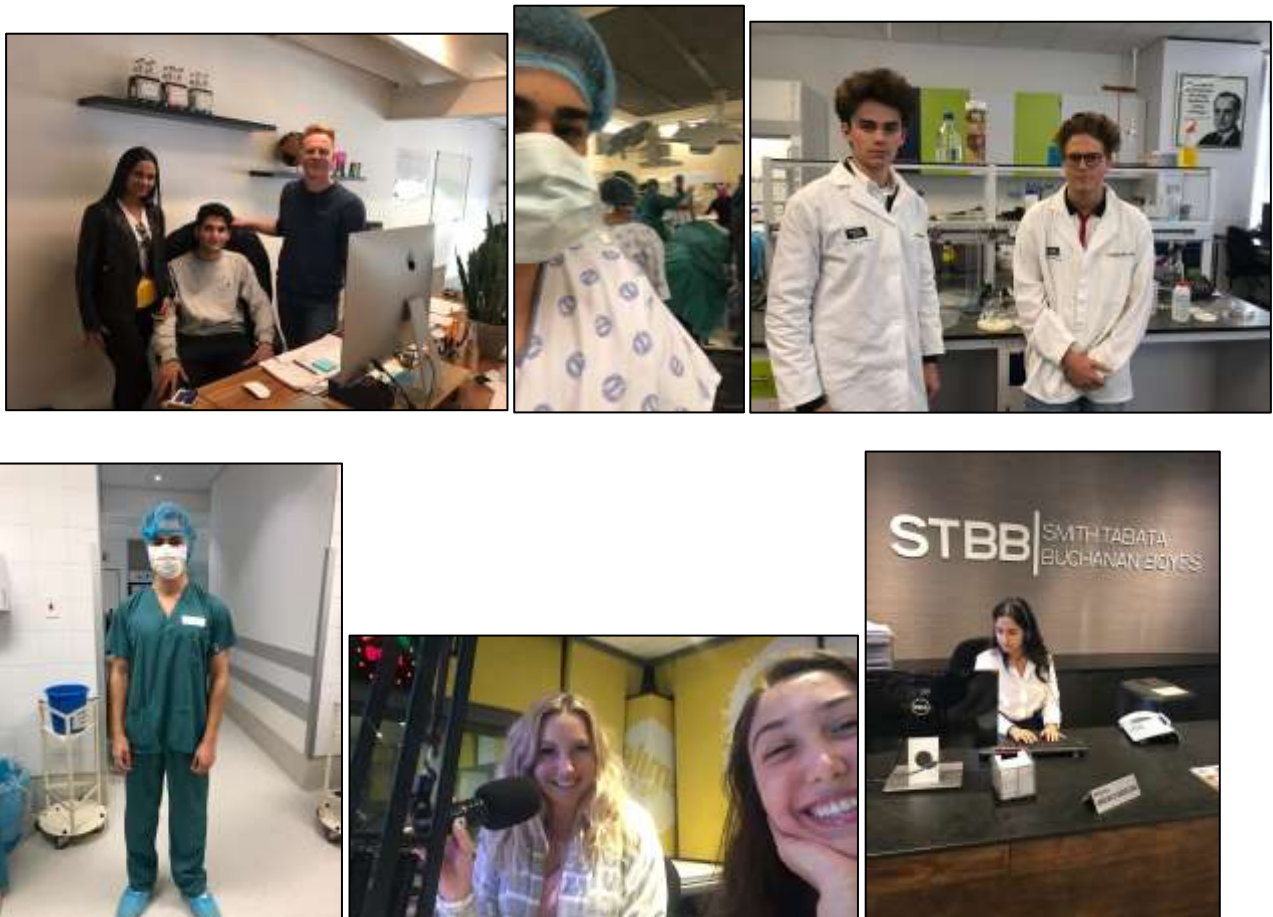

Our lovely volunteer mom, Mrs Jill Coetzee, has indicated that she desperately needs your 2nd hand books. Please see her request below:

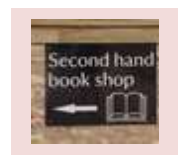


“It is that time of the year again when parents are asking for second hand books, but I don’t have enough stock.
